**BB** Group reads and discusses the **Big Book**

**C** **Closed Meeting** - For alcoholics only. Tradition 3 states the only requirement for membership is a desire to stop drinking

**CC** **Child Care** available

**CF** Meetings held in a **Correctional Facility**

**CR** Meeting in a correctional facility that has **Clearance Required**

**D** Meeting for **Discussion** on anything alcohol related

**DR** Group reads and discusses the day's topic from the book **Daily Reflections**

**E** **English Speaking** - for our meetings near the Canadian border and in Canada

**ESH** A meeting that reads and discusses a story from the book **Experience, Strength & Hope**

**F** **French Speaking** - for our meetings near the Canadian border and in Canada

**F/E** **French and English**

**G** A meeting that discusses **Gay/Lesbian** issues as related to their alcoholism

**GV** Group reads and discusses an article from the **Grapevine** publication

**H** Meeting held in a **Hospital**

**I** Meeting held in an **Institution**

**L** Meeting where AA **Literature** is available for sale

**LS** Group reads and discusses the day's topic from the book **Living Sober**

**M** A meeting that discusses **Men's** issues as related to their alcoholism

**MED** A meeting usually based on the 11th Step is a **Meditation** meeting

**O** **Open** meeting can be attended by alcoholics, their friends, family, or anyone interested in AA

**P** Meeting based on the **Promises** of AA

**S** Meeting where **Smoking** is permitted

**SL** A meeting which discusses AA's **Slogans**

**SP** A meeting with one or more alcoholics sharing what it was like, what happened and what it is like now is a **Speaker** Meeting

**SPAN** **Spanish** speaking meeting

**ST** Group reads and discusses AA's **12 Steps**

**T** Usually a discussion meeting where after a person shares they "**Tag**" the next person to speak

**TP** A discussion meeting based on an alcohol related **Topic**

**TR** Group reads and discusses AA's **12 Traditions**

**W** A meeting that discusses **Women's** issues as related to their alcoholism
